The Order of Business Follows:

- Motion approved to Accept resignation of Penny Murden as of December 31, 2019. To fill the vacancy, the Board requested that AE send out a request via email and Facebook to the membership to fill the vacancy. Discussion followed regarding the importance of having an appraiser sit on the Board of Directors. However, since most appraisers do not meet the criteria of committee participation, the Bylaws Committee was asked to consider a revision in the Bylaws to allow this exception for an Appraiser. Motion was approved to dedicate one spot to an appraiser member when and if available.
- Motion approved to implement more timely notices regarding updates and changes to Paragon. Membership needs to be assured that the Board is considering all options.
